Web Design 12 (3 credits) (creating web pages with HTML)

Alice Programming (NEW!) and Web Design 12 are both entry level introduction courses and good selections for your first 100% online experience!!

Cisco 11, 12A and 12B have some interactive sessions on Thursday nights at 6:00 so prepare to be by your computer or come to the class held at W.J. Mouat Secondary in Abbotsford. The interactive computer sessions may be recorded so you can watch at a later date if you can't participate live!
